**Stations Of The Cross:** will be held at 9.45 am each morning of Lent before Mass- Monday to Friday-unless there is a funeral. Stations of the Cross and Benediction will be held on Sunday of Lent at 4.00 pm The second collection during Lent is for sick and retired Priests. The only exception to this is the 4th Sunday of Lent when the second collection will be for SC1AF.

**Lenten Deanery Mass:** The Lenten Deanery Mass this year will take place at 7 pm in St. Michael's Dumbarton on Monday 8th of March. The Archbishop will preside and Fr. Willie Brandon SMA will Preach. There will be hospitality in the Hall after Mass. The Archbishop has asked that no other Masses be said that day in the Deanery to encourage a coming together of the faithful with the Bishop on their Lenten journey.

**Service of Reconciliation and Healing** - we are hosting this service jointly with St. Michael's Parish and St Patrick's Church at 7.30 pm on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> March. This is presented by Fr Willie Brandon, an SMA Father from Dunblane who will preach and the Fiat Prayer Group of Glasgow will bring with them a statue of Our Lady of Reconciliation; they too will provide their own music ministry. During the service there will be prayers for healing and those who wish can come to the altar to be prayed over for healing in their lives - any sort of healing they feel they need. Even people who cannot go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) are most welcome to come and ask for healing in their lives through the intercession of Our Lady of Reconciliation. No matter who you are, or what religion you are, you will be welcome. This will be followed by an invitation to go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation for those who are eligible.
