It is deeply troubling that so many MSPs are so supportive of a law which will make it illegal to pray in certain parts of the country, in an unprecedented attack on freedom of religion. Only John Mason MSP, member for Glasgow Shettleston, voted against the proposals. Anyone disobeying the proposed law will be criminalised with fines and/or imprisonment. It will even prohibit certain conduct within homes, churches and schools in
